



Ice Skating Victoria Elite Athlete Development Policy

Purpose

The Ice Skating Victoria (ISV) Elite Athlete Development Policy has been developed to describe the process for skaters applying to participate in the Icehouse Elite Athlete Development (IEAD) program.

The IEAD program is for athletes who demonstrate ability of potential to succeed at a high level in National and International competitions.

Application Procedure

To be considered for the IEAD program skaters must be currently competing at a minimum of Primary level.

Skaters must apply through ISV. Skaters applying from interstate or internationally may be requested to provide test records, competition records and coaching details.

All skaters applying must be current members of ISV or their relevant State Ice Skating Association. Skater's coaches must be a current member, in good standing, of APSA.

Selection Procedure

ISV National Senior and/or International level judges in consultation with the ISA High Performance Director will determine if the skater is a suitable candidate for the IEAD program.

ISV will inform the Icehouse of the skater's suitability.

Skater/Coach Responsibility

Selected skaters and their coaches must abide by the Icehouse Athlete Development Policy, and conduct their activities in accordance with both the ISV and ISA Code of Ethics.
